1. Training providers/colleges must be registered with an awarding body (CSkills/Edexcel, City and Guilds).
2. Training providers/colleges must submit the number of candidates registered for qualification NVQ2, NVQ3/SVQ2, SVQ3 in drylining.
3. They must also provide the number of NVQ2, NVQ3/SVQ2, SVQ3 qualifications they have achieved.
4. The period for which this information is required is 1st January to 31st December 2017.
5. All entries must be accompanied by the awarding body evidence verifying registrations/achievements and course type for the set date parameters.
6. The basis for determining the winner of the British Gypsum Trophy will be the greatest number of achievements at NVQ2, NVQ3/SVQ2, SVQ3 compared to the number of registrations.
7. The Judging Panel's decision will be final.
